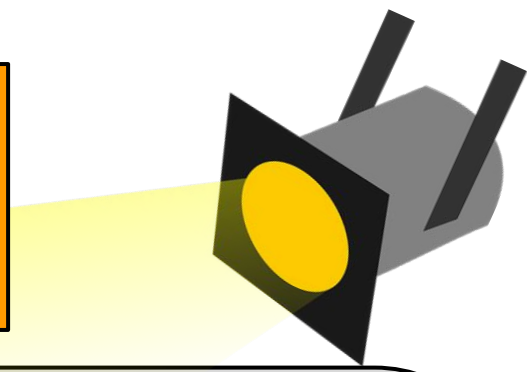

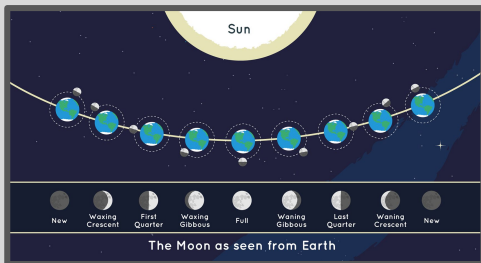

Science:

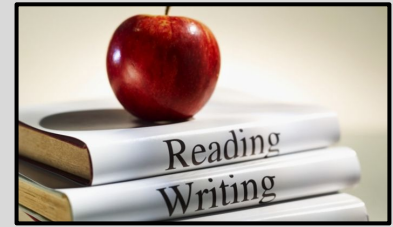
Our class topic for the month of April is the relationship between the Sun, Moon, and Earth. Students will study moon phases, eclipses, and tides.



English Language Arts:

Students will be reviewing key concepts leading up to PSSA testing. Topics that will be practiced include TDA writing.

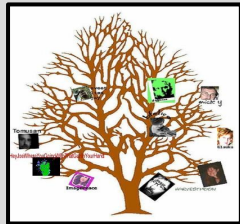
Social Studies:
