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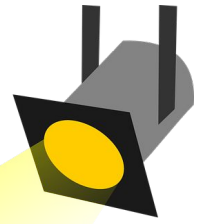
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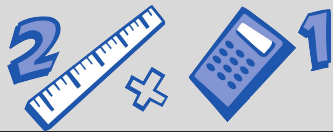

SUBJECT SPOTLIGHT:



Mathematics:

You will notice that your student will be bringing home the Homelinks book for Everyday Math assignments (or Glencoe Course 2 Book for Advanced Math.). We encourage you to review concepts with your student at home and to check Firefly for daily homework your child may be assigned. Homework allows your child to practice the skills learned in class.



Social Studies:

6th grade is beginning the school year learning about The Articles of Confederation and Creating our United States Constitution. We will discuss what the framers hoped to accomplish and how they created checks and balances in the federal system.



Science:

6th grade will be kicking off the year with studying Meteorology! As long as the weather cooperates, we will be spending a lot of time outdoors, taking a first hand look at the weather around us. Not only will we be focusing on the types of weather, but also how weather is measured. We will be constructing our own barometers, anemometers and wind vanes, and using our weather stations to gather data daily.

ELA:

This month in Language Arts we will be starting with our Narrative Writing unit. The reading skills that we will be working on include: character, setting and plot.
