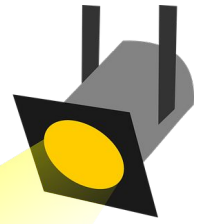

8th Grade students will be exploring the importance of understanding the five themes of geography and how they are applied to our daily lives and in possible careers that utilize geographic skills.



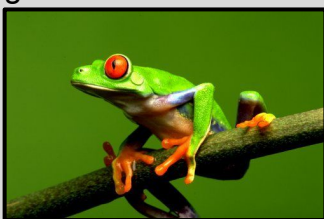
English Language Arts:
