# **Mathematics:**

Sixth Grade EDM students are off to a great start working through Unit I Data Displays and Number Systems, while Advanced Math students are working through Decimal Operations. All students will be taking the Study Island Benchmark the week of Aug 30th. These assessments are given three times a year to measure students' growth, areas of strengths, as well as areas in math that need improvement. # **Social Studies:**

In Social Studies classes, 6th graders are learning about current events around the world daily. Additionally, we have started our JA Biztown Unit where students will learn about Communities and the Economy. Our learning will help us prepare for our field trip to JA Biztown in October. # Science:

We will be beginning our year with the unit Introduction to Meteorology. We will discuss the layers of the atmosphere, their role and how heat transfers throughout the layers. We will then travel through the water cycle, learning about the formation of clouds and why we have the precipitation we do. As we learn about the various types of weather, we will study the role of the meteorologist and how they use weather tools to predict the weather from day to day.

# ELA:
