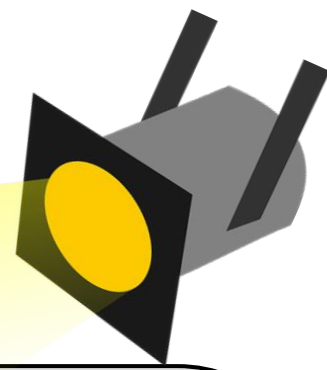

7th Grade Subject Spotlight



Science:

In seventh grade Science class, students will continue to study Meteorology. Students will also investigate weather factors and begin to predict weather based on those factors. In addition, students will study storms and other catastrophic events.



English Language Arts:

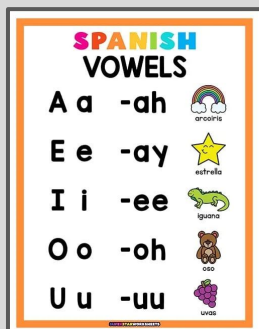
Social Studies:

In the next few weeks of Social Studies, students will be exploring some of the first civilizations to develop in the ancient world. We will explore the river-valley civilizations of Mesopotamia, Egypt, India, and China.



Spanish:
