Ask your student what PRIDE stands for.



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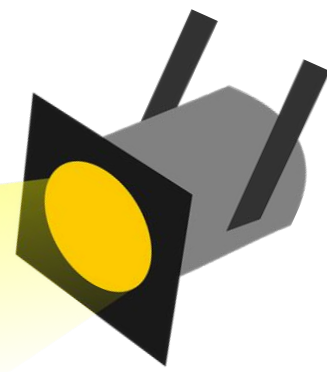


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7th Grade Subject Spotlight

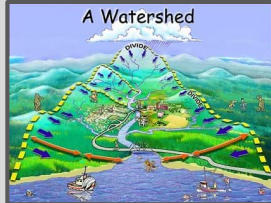


Science:

The Scientific Method will be the first topic

discussed in science this school year.

Throughout seventh grade, students will learn how to apply the scientific method to concepts including weather, climate, and Earth's resources. Students will also explore water and watersheds as well as the structure of the universe.



English Language Arts:

In seventh grade, students will learn how to utilize credible sources to complete research, interact and analyze pieces of literature, and improve their vocabulary through a number of different online tools including iReady. Students will also continue to develop their writing skills in the areas of argumentative, narrative, and informative writing.



Social Studies:

Cultures of the ancient world will be the topic of seventh grade Social Studies this school year. Students will learn about and utilize archaeological and historical research techniques in order to learn about the world that existed long ago.
